

The inclusion of the world-first inland wave lagoon on the UK Pro Surf Tour schedule is a major development for the tour, which showcases the best surfing locations as well as the best surfers in the UK.

The UK Pro Surf Tour, which kicked off in May at Watergate Bay, sees the UK's best surfers travelling the length and breadth of the country from the sandy beaches of Cornwall to the rugged North Scottish coast in search of the best waves. The Tour takes in six stops in all, with the final one back in Newquay, Cornwall in October.

On 16 September it will arrive at Surf Snowdonia, when the UK's top male, and female surfers will compete in a knock-out competition format for the third Surf Snowdonia Pro Surf Challenge. With a substantial cash prize up for grabs and a chance to ride the UK's only Wave Park, this event is a definite favourite among our surfers.

This one-day event starting at 8.00am will be broadcast live with scores, interviews and all the action available to watch on our website and on Facebook Live. Entry to watch the event, sponsored by Conwy Council, will be free of charge and is set to draw a large family crowd for a day of friendly but hugely exciting and intense competition.

There will be indoor and outdoor seated and standing viewing areas, free parking on site along with refreshments and snacks available all day at the Surf Snowdonia restaurant, deli and bar.
